He cooked fettuccine (ribbon pasta) and added butter and parmesan cheese in his restaurant Alfredo Alla Scrofa in Rome to spice the dish up. Did you know: The restaurant situated at Via della Scrofa 104 still exists! And you can still order his famous dishes.

Menu:

Carpaccio of beef served with pesto and Grana Padano

or

Tartar of tuna accompanied with a seaweed salad and sesameoil

or

Spanish bell pepper soup with corn

Pork tenderloin filled with ricotta cheese and dried ham served with a sage sauce

or

Skin fried sea bream with thym, lemon and garlic

or

Penne pasta Alfredo with a green salad and freshly grated cheese

Warm chocolate tartlet served with a scoop of cherry ice-cream and a vanilla sauce

or

A variety of cheeses with a slice of raisin bread and a homemade compote of figs

or

Vanilla parfait with a lime mousse and marinated pineapple
